**SUBJECT:** Consideration of a resolution authorizing the Village Administrator to execute an agreement with Groot Industries for Solid Waste and Recycling Services

## **SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:**

The Village of Antioch desires to enter into a contract for a five (5) year period with an option, by mutual agreement, to extend the contract for one-year periods for up to five (5) additional years, for refuse collection and disposal, and collection of recyclables and landscape waste for delivery to permitted and/or approved facilities from the Village and from all single-family residences, townhouses, duplexes and condominium dwelling units with up to four units. Collection location, method and frequency, of the refuse, recyclables and yard waste, shall be based on the RFP or as mutually agreed upon by the Village and the successful Contractor.

The following proposals were submitted for consideration:

The numbers above represent Groot's use of their facility for disposal of recycling. Use of other facilities results in a \$0.50 increase to \$16.90 for the 65g cart and \$19.03 for the 95g cart. Waste management also offered a revised cost proposal that was above that of Groot.

Upon final review, staff recommends approving a contract with Groot Industries for its municipal waste collection.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

This contract represents a decrease in current pricing to residents provided by Waste Management.

In addition to offering the lowest bid, Groot has agreed to provide services for municipal collections and port-a-potties at Village-sponsored events and venues. Other services provided in the proposal include leaf vacuuming, landscape waste collection for a period longer than the current service, Christmas Tree Pickup, bulk item collection, spring clean-up day, and all other services for which residents are currently accustomed. The proposal also includes the use of

compressed natural gas vehicles, Thursday pickup service Village-wide, and communication to residents regarding the transition.

**A resolution authorizing the Village Administrator to execute an agreement with Groot Industries for Solid Waste and Recycling Services**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the municipal waste contract is a basic service, contracted by the Village on behalf of the residents; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the best interest of Antioch to provide the citizens with reliable, environmentally safe removal of garbage, recyclables and landscape waste; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract for said service is due for renewal; and

**WHEREAS**, proposals were received to perform said service from **Waste Management of Illinois, Advanced Disposal** and **Groot Industries**; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest proposal was received from Groot Industries to provide said service;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, to authorize the Village Administrator to finalize an agreement with Groot Industries for solid waste and recycling services, and to arrange for the orderly transition of services from Waste Management to Groot.
