SUBJECT: Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing the Village Administrator to approve the purchase of a 2001 International Horton Ambulance from the Village of Streamwood.

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

The Village of Streamwood Fire Department has retired their Ambulance 32 from service. This vehicle is in very good condition and well maintained by the Village mechanics. At present, the vehicle has just over 91,000 miles on the chassis. The motor underwent a complete overhaul in 2011. It has been a reserve vehicle since 2009. The vehicle includes a striker power cot as part of the purchase. This vehicle will provide the Fire Department with a dedicated reserve ambulance in the event another of our ambulances is out of service. The First Fire Protection District has indicated they will approve this joint purchase at their August 13th board meeting, pending approval by the Village. Said ambulance shall be available for delivery to the Antioch Fire Department in September.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Cost of \$12,000 which will be shared 50/50 with the First Fire District

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2001 INTERNATIONAL HORTON AMBULANCE FROM THE VILLAGE OF STREAMWOOD

WHEREAS, the mission of the Antioch Fire Department is to provide fire and life safety services to the community, and

WHEREAS, the Antioch Fire Department currently provides emergency medical services within the Village of Antioch as a principal part of their mission, and

WHEREAS, the Antioch Fire Department has determined that it would be an efficient cost effective solution to purchase a used ambulance to supplement its immediate fleet needs, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Streamwood intends to sell their 2001 International Horton to the Antioch Fire Department as a reserve response vehicle, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section One: The Village Administrator is authorized and directed to effectuate the purchase of the above-described ambulance to be used for emergency medical service to the Antioch Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$12,000, provided that half of the purchase price is being paid for by the First Fire Protection District.

Section Two: The Administrator is further directed to work with the First Fire District of Antioch Township regarding the shared purchase of this ambulance.
