SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §7-3-10 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH ADDING TWO STOP SIGNS ON HILLSIDE AND HARDEN

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

At the September 16, 2015 Committee of the Whole and September 21 and October 5, 2015 Village Board meetings, the village board discussed the issue of traffic near the intersection of Hillside Avenue and Harden Street; specifically it being used as a cut-through to avoid the signaled intersection of Route 173 and 59.

At the October 5, 2015 Village Board meeting, a motion was approved to direct the attorney to draft ordinance changes for stop signs at Hillside Avenue and Harden Street, direct staff to stripe at low cost efforts, draft policy for every neighborhood to have traffic calming techniques, and direct staff and engineering consultant to prepare a plan for the affected are in the spring for traffic or speed tables.

The proposed ordinance follows the first part of the motion approved at the October 5, 2015 Village Board meeting to direct the attorney to draft ordinance changes for stop signs at Hillside Avenue and Harden Street.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §7-3-10
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH
ADDING TWO STOP SIGNS ON HILLSIDE AND HARDEN**

WHEREAS, the Village Board has recently held public meetings on the topic of safety on Hillside Avenue and Harden Street, which are frequently used as a shortcut around the intersection of Illinois Highways 173 and 59, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has found that additional traffic calming techniques need to be added to these streets in order to improve public safety, and

WHEREAS, among those techniques that are needed are two stop signs at the intersection of the two roads,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The chart of stop signs included in Section 7-3-10 of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended, additions underlined, deletions stricken:

Street	Stop At	Direction
Harden	Hillside	east <u>west</u>
<u>Hillside</u>	<u>Harden</u>	<u>North</u>

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
