

POLICE OFFICER

The Board of Fire and Police Commissioners is accepting applications to establish an eligibility list for future openings in the Antioch Police Department. The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Commissioners will govern all applicants.

Application forms may be obtained at www.antioch.il.gov or www.antiochpd.com. There is a non-refundable \$20.00 application fee. Completed applications must be filed at the Antioch Police Department or the Antioch Village Hall on or before October 17, 2014.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must:

1. Be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Have a High School Diploma or equivalent.
3. Be between the ages of 21 and 35, except that Applicants who are 20 years of age and have successfully completed two (2) years of law enforcement studies at an accredited college or university shall be eligible to take the initial examination for Patrol Officer.
4. Have a valid driver's license.
5. Be of good moral character and no felony convictions.
6. Be able to successfully complete a written test, oral board review, background investigation, psychological and polygraph tests as well as a pre-employment medical and physical ability examinations.
7. Meet all other requirements of the Fire and Police Commission.

Orientation and Physical Agility Testing will be held at the Antioch Police Department, 433 Orchard Street, Antioch, on Saturday, November 1, 2014 at 8:00 A.M.

Starting salary is \$51,563 with a generous benefit package.
