**DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENING** School District #34 offers a free developmental screening for children ages 3-5 who are not yet eligible for kindergarten and reside within District 34 boundaries. What is a developmental screening? A child's cognitive, fine and gross motor, speech and language, vision and hearing, self-help and social emotional skills are screened. **SCHOOL CLOSINGS, SNOWY WEATHER** In preparation for potentially adverse weather conditions, we provide you with the following information: Camp Crayon follows the same bad weather closings as announced by Antioch School District #34. You may also tune in to the school closing information on WKRS Radio (1220 AM) when the weather is questionable. Camp Crayon does not make up days missed due to inclement weather nor do we give refunds. If your child wears boots to school, please send him/her with a pair of dry shoes to change into upon arrival at school. This will help us keep the floor as dry/clean as possible to avoid slipping and falling.

### REMINDERS

\*Place a change of clothes in your child's back pack. From time to time we do projects in which your child may get wet, or they may have an accident. It's best to be prepared.

\*Please continue to check your email regularly.

\*As the weather gets nicer, there is a lot to learn outside! We will do our best to let you know which days we are going outside. However, if you are watching the news and notice an unseasonably warm day, plan for a recess at school.
