Greetings parents!

Next Tuesday is our Wheeling Water Park field trip! As a reminder, all campers must always be dropped off by 9 a.m. every day, ESPECIALLY on field trips days. Sometimes our bus leaves as early as 9 a.m. or 9:15 a.m. For special drop-off or pick-up circumstances (i.e. appointments, summer school, athletics), campers can be dropped off or picked up at the Williams Park Pavilion between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. Otherwise, pick-up will be at the Scout House between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. every afternoon.

If your child is enrolled in swim lessons, you have two options: either send your child to camp and they will miss swim lessons for the field trip, or you are responsible for bringing them to swim lessons and they cannot attend camp that day. This applies to all field trip days.

Also, please be sure that your camper or campers are coming to camp with a lunch as well as a healthy morning snack and afternoon snack each day—the counselors have reminded campers several times to not eat all of their food in the morning or at lunch time so they have food throughout the day.


