- CALL TO ORDER A meeting of the Antioch Police Commission was called to order by Chairman Jerry Kozenski on January 09, 2007 at 5:30PM
- PRESENT Attending the meeting were Commissioners Jerry Kozenski, Deidre Palmer, and Kevin Schoudel, Attorney Jim Bakk and Secretary Jane Pensala.
- MINUTES A motion was made by Kevin Schoudel and seconded by Deidre Palmer to approve the minutes from the October 10, 2006 meeting. The motion carried with a majority yes vote.
- TREASURERS REPORT A motion was made by Deidre Palmer and seconded by Kevin Schoudel to approve the 2006 treasurers report as presented with expenditures totaling \$4913.40 and \$850.00 turned over to the Village Hall for monies received for police officer applications. The motion carried with a majority yes vote.
- A motion was made by Deidre Palmer and seconded by Jerry Kozenski to approve payment for the quarterly statement from Attorney Jim Bakk for legal services. The motion carried with a majority yes vote.
- OLD BUSINESS Regarding pending litigation - Jerry Kozenski related that a brief has been presented for review. No further information at this time.
- NEW BUSINESS The form the Commissioners use for oral interviews will be reviewed by the Board with any changes or amendments to be discussed at the next meeting.
- Amendments to the Rules and Regulations of the Police Commission were discussed. The amendments and/or changes are to be presented to the Antioch Village Board for approval. Upon approval, the amendments and/or changes will be published after a final review by the Commissioners.

CORRESPONDENCE

A letter was received from Metro-Western Cook Credit Services, Inc. describing their services and cost for credit reports on police officer applicants. Commissioner Deidre Palmer is to check with the company regarding their services. The information will be given to the Board at the next meeting.
