- CALL TO ORDER            A meeting of the Antioch Police Commission was called to order by Chairman Jerry Kozenski at 6:00PM on October 01, 2009 at the Antioch Police Conference Room, 433 Orchard Street, Antioch, IL 60002
- AGENDA                    A motion was made by Jim Kinney and seconded by Jerry Kozenski to approve the agenda as presented. The motion carried with a majority yes vote.
- ROLL CALL                Attending the meeting were Commissioners Jerry Kozenski, Jim Kinney, and Angela Brooks and secretary Jane Pensala.
- MINUTES                  A motion was made by Jim Kinney and seconded by Angela Brooks to approve the minutes from the September 03, 2009 meeting. The motion carried with a majority yes vote.
- TREASURERS REPORT    A motion was made by Jim Kinney and seconded by Angela Brooks to approve for payment, by the Village Hall, the statement from Dr. Dennis Selvig, in the amount of \$500.00, for pre-employment psychological evaluation for the next eligible police officer candidate on 09-16-09 and approve for payment the statement from Hunter and Associates in the amount of \$300.00 for polygraph testing for police officer candidates on 08-24-09 and 09-24-09. The motion carried with a majority yes vote.
- OLD BUSINESS            The final eligibility list for the Sergeant's position was presented to the Commissioners. At this time there are no military credits due to any of the applicants. A motion was made by Jerry Kozenski and seconded by Angela Brooks to approve the list as corrected. The motion carried with a majority yes vote. Copies of the list will be presented to the Chief of Police and to the Village Hall for posting.
- A candidate who failed to pass the psychological and polygraph

evaluations contacted the Police Commission asking if he could appeal the results of the evaluations. Upon speaking with Attorney Long, he advised that at this time, there are no provisions in the state statutes or local ordinances that allow for an appeal.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Jim Kinney and seconded by Angela Brooks to pass John Parello as the next police officer candidate for hire. The motion carried with a majority yes vote. A letter will be given to Chief Foerster regarding the consensus of the Commission.

Meeting dates for the Commission in the year 2010 are as follows: January 12, 2010; April 13, 2010, July 13, 2010, and October 12, 2010. Meetings to begin at 6:00PM at the Antioch Police Department.
