Recycle your broken or unwanted electronics

HOUSEHOLD ELECTRONICS AT HOME PICK-UP

Have up to 5 electronic items, including one TV, picked up directly from your home (single-family homes with front door access only) for \$25.00.

Schedule your appointment now!

When: During regular waste/recycling pick-up date, the week of February 6, 2012 (February 6-10). For details and information, and to schedule a pick-up, call Waste Management, **1-800-796-9696**.

Guidelines:

- Must call by February 2nd and pick-up must be prepaid prior to service.
- All items must be placed at top of driveway by 7 am, day of service.
- Please tape electrical cords to the item.
- Additional fee of \$25.00 required for each additional TV.
- Small electronics (cell phones, calculators, etc.) and peripheral items (mice, cords, keyboards, etc.) can be placed in a box no larger than 2' x 2' and will counts as one item.
- No refunds will be given if you forget to put your electronics out.

Accepted Items Include: TV's, Computers/Accessories, Monitors, Keyboards, Scanners, Printers, Cellular Phones, Stereos, Portable Music Players (MP3s), Alkaline and Rechargeable Batteries*, Holiday Lights, CD Players, DVD Players, VCR's, Cameras, Video Games, Telephones, Fax Machines, Shredders, Microwaves and Small Household Appliances.

Not Accepted: No commercial or business materials will be accepted. Dehumidifiers, air conditioners, lead-acid batteries, large appliances and household chemical waste will not be accepted.

* **IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT BATTERIES:** To avoid the risk of cross contact of battery terminals that can result in sparking and possible fire, residents must place a piece of household tape over the contact points on each rechargeable battery or place each rechargeable battery into a self-locking plastic baggie (one rechargeable battery per bag).
