

3 Year Old Classes - February Newsletter

Fourth Session - It is hard to believe, but the fourth session is about to begin! The first day of the fourth session starts on February 9 for the Tues./Thurs. class and on February 24 for the M/W Class. \$95.00 Residents/\$115 Non-Residents. No Camp - Camp will not be in session on Monday, February 15 due to President's Day.

Valentine Parties - Our parties will be held on Wednesday, February 10 for the M/W Class and on Thursday, February 11 for the T/TH Class. Please send 20 Valentines, candy or little treats are optional. **DO NOT** address valentines to their individual friends.

DO have your child's name in the "from" section of the card. If they would like to try writing their own names, please help them, but don't worry if they aren't up to the task. It's okay if a parent fills them out.

Registration for Camp Crayon 2010/2011 –

Priority registration will be given to children currently in our 3 year-old Camp Crayon class. We offer three classes for four year-olds:

*Classes are filled on a first come/first serve basis.

Priority registration begins on Friday, March 5 at 8:45 a.m. and closes on Thursday, March 11 at 5:00 p.m. Registration is held at the Parks and Recreation Office, 806 Holbek Drive. Registration forms will be placed in your child's cubby on March 1 & 2. Forms will also be available at the Parks Office beginning March 1. We make the forms available a little early so you can have it completed in order to speed the registration process. Pricing for the 2010/11 school year will stay the same, however, there will be a \$50.00 non-refundable **registration fee** required at the time of registration. Make checks payable to the Village of Antioch. We do not need a copy of your child's birth certificate, as long as you have already provided one.

Please note: 40 children are able to pre-register. **If you have a class preference, you should be in line a little early on March 5 to assure your class selection as each class has only 20 spots. The B.K. A.M. class fills up quickly!*

Registration for the general public will take place for Village Residents on Saturday, March 13 from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. in the classroom of the Parks Building. Village residents have a 1,2,3 or 4 digit address and live inside the Village limits. Antioch Township residents can register on the same day from 11:00 a.m. until noon. If openings are still available, Non-Residents can register on Monday, March 22 at 9:00 a.m. at the Parks and Recreation office.

2010/2011 classes will begin the week of September 13, 2009. If you have any questions about registration, please see Miss Debbie or Miss Karen.

Heart Theme Day- February 3rd & 4th get ready for a heart filled day! Thank you to those who have already signed up to bring snack for the day which will be: red or pink yogurt and red fruit.

Snowy Weather - If your child wears boots to school, please bring a pair of dry shoes to change into upon arrival to Camp. Help us keep the floor as dry/clean as possible to avoid slipping and falling.

When To Keep Your Child Home From Camp- We are pretty healthy here at Camp Crayon for this time of year, but we thought it would be good to review guidelines on when to keep your child home due to illness. Here are our recommendations:

- 1.** Acute Cold
- 2.** Sore throat or earache
- 3.** Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or abdominal pain
- 4.** Signs of listlessness, weakness, chills, headache or fever
- 5.** Swollen glands
- 6.** Eyes – tearing, irritation, redness, swelling of lids, pus discharge, aversion to light
- 7.** Mouth/Lungs – acute cough, open sores inside or outside, persistent foul odor on breath (not caused by diet or medication)

Children should not return to Camp for 24 – 48 hours after vomiting has ended.
Children should be fever free for at least 24-48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.

Bragging- We are so proud of what a great job all of the children are doing this year, they are simply amazing! They are making great progress with name recognition – keep reminding them to check for their own name on the board and keep practicing writing names at home. Show and Tell has been running smoothly as each child takes a turn being in the spotlight, answering questions about their prized possessions.
