## Theme Day:

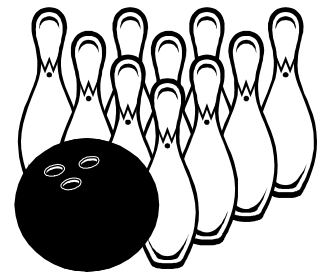

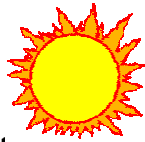
# COUNSELOR SPOTLIGHT
