Resolution to Declare as Surplus Fire Ambulance 2143

WHEREAS, the mission of the Antioch Fire Department is to provide fire and life safety services to the community, and

WHEREAS, the Antioch Fire Department currently provides emergency medical services within the Village of Antioch as a principal part of their mission, and

WHEREAS, from time to time certain vehicles reach the end of their useful life and must be properly removed from service and disposed of; and

WHEREAS, Ambulance 2143, VIN # 1FV3ELBD61HG95417 is a 2001 Freightliner medium duty Ambulance which is assigned to fire station 1 as reserve service to the Antioch Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Ambulance 2143 is an end of life asset with over 120,000 miles and is no longer suitable for use as an emergency response vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch does hereby declare that the above listed vehicle is surplus and no longer of use to the Antioch Fire Department.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fire Chief is authorized to dispose of these vehicles in the best means practicable for their fair market value.
