A JOINT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND SUPPORTING A PETITON OF ANNEXATION OF VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH TERRITORY INTO THE FIRST FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ANTIOCH TOWNSHIP

This resolution entered into jointly be the Village of Antioch (hereinafter the "Village"), First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township (hereinafter the "District") and Antioch Township (hereinafter the "Township"), (jointly hereinafter the "Governing Bodies")

WHEREAS, For many years the District provided Fire Protection to the unincorporated portions of Antioch Township and the Village providing Fire Protection of the Village of Antioch; and

WHEREAS, The Village and the District have a long-standing Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to share certain responsibilities for operating the Fire Department to serve areas within the Village of Antioch and in the unincorporated area of Antioch Township; and

WHEREAS, Ambulance service in both the Village and unincorporated area had been provided by Antioch Rescue a not for profit organization. The facilitating of ambulance service through Antioch Rescue stopped in the Village in 2013 and in 2014 for the unincorporated area; and

WHEREAS, in 2015 the voters of both the Village of Antioch and the unincorporated area of Antioch Township supported an new ambulance tax to support ambulance service; and

WHEREAS, the community was told if they supported the ambulance tax the Governing Bodies would support a consolidated Fire and Rescue body with an elected five member board. This structure would be more efficient and provide a broader range of representation throughout the Village and unincorporated areas of Antioch Township; and

WHEREAS, in order to achieve combines elected five member elected board, the voters of the Village of Antioch will be asked to support the annexation of the territory into the First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township (70 ILCS 705/3 (a)), followed by the adoption of an ordinance by Antioch Township changing the appointed board to an elected board (70 ILCS 705/4 a) and the adoption of an ordinance by the First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township changing its board from a three member board to a five member board (70 ILCS 705/4.01); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Bodies jointly support the proposed annexation and conversion to an elected five member board;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Antioch, First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township and Antioch Township, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Village of Antioch, First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township and Antioch Township, support the proposed annexation of the village territory into the District.

SECTION TWO: The Village of Antioch, First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township and Antioch Township thereafter support the conversion of the District board to a five person elected board.
