

RESOLUTION NO. 16-86

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING A RECREATIONAL SERVICES PROGRAM WITH THE VILLAGE OF LAKE VILLA

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch Parks and Recreation has been in discussion with Lake Villa about the use of Lehman Mansion for events/activities; and

WHEREAS, an intergovernmental agreement will assist both agencies in collectively pursuing a recreational services partnership.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to pursue these services collaboratively to provide enhanced recreational services to their residents; and

WHEREAS, Antioch desires to hold recreational programming at a facility owned and operated by the Village of Lake Villa, which is outside the boundaries of the Antioch; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement provides the ability to hold events in conjunction with the Village of Lake Villa at the Lehman Mansion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Mayor and Village Board to Authorizing the Mayor to Execute an Intergovernmental Agreement Establishing a Recreational Services Program with the Village of Lake Villa.
