

RESOLUTION 19-55

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH
EXTENDING A DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch (hereinafter, the “Village”) has suffered serious damage to public infrastructure, including roads and utilities owned by or serving the Village resulting from the formation of a Sinkhole located on private property at the Northeastern corner of Main and Orchard Streets within the Corporate Limits of the Village; and

WHEREAS, as a result of ongoing and heavy rainfall, the Sinkhole continues to expand further threatening other roads, utilities and both public and privately held property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to his authority authorized by the Illinois Emergency Management Act (hereinafter, the “Act”), 20 ILCS 3305/11, and Village Code Section 2-8-4, Mayor Lawrence M. Hanson issued a local emergency declaration on September 20th, 2019; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, such disaster declaration shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven days except by or with the consent of the Village Board of Trustees, to be published as directed in the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees hereby finds that the conditions in the Village require and necessitate the extension of the Declaration of Emergency until rescinded by the Mayor or by Resolution of this Board of Trustees upon a determination that the local disaster or emergency conditions no longer exist;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth here.

SECTION TWO: That a state of local disaster emergency is in effect in the incorporated areas of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, which shall continue until the sinkhole and the conditions caused by said sinkhole are abated, and until rescinded by the Mayor or by resolution of the Board of Trustees upon a determination that the local disaster or emergency conditions no longer exist.


SECTION THREE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage, and shall promptly be filed with the Village Clerk, pursuant to statute.
