

**RESOLUTION 19-58**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE ADMINISTRATOR  
TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH TROTTER AND ASSOCIATES, INC FOR AN  
ENGINEERING STUDY REGARDING THE WWTF SOLID TRACK**

**WHEREAS**, the Gravity Thickener and the Moyno Sludge Transfer Pump are not working as intended, and

**WHEREAS**, the Gravity Thickener has wholly failed and is no longer functioning, and

**WHEREAS**, The Moyno Sludge Transfer Pump failed three times already this year and is required to transport the bio-solid from belt filter press to the sludge storage barn; this is a mission-critical piece of equipment, and

**WHEREAS**, this study will evaluate these issues and provide solutions with cost estimates to fix said issues, and

**WHEREAS**, the study will also explore the costs and processes in producing an EPA class A bio-solid

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, to authorize the Village Administrator to execute an agreement with **TROTTER AND ASSOCIATES** for an engineering study regarding the WWTF solid track for \$36,000
