A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH H.R. GREEN FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATING TO GRIMM ROAD

WHEREAS, the Village was forced to close Grimm Road approximately a year ago due to its severely deteriorating condition and unsafe alignment with Illinois State Highway 173, and

WHEREAS, a new, properly aligned Grimm Road is essential for a number of reasons, including, but not limited to, its status as a collector and bypass route to alleviate traffic jams at the intersection of Illinois State Highways 173 and 83, and its ability to open a large parcel of land purchased for commercial development purposes to its north commonly referred to as the Boylan property, and

WHEREAS, the first critical step in the redevelopment of Grimm Road is the engineering of the newly realigned right of way along with the development of plans for utilities, stormwater, sidewalks, and other public improvements, and

WHEREAS, H.R. Green has submitted a proposal to do this engineering, in the form attached as Exhibit A hereto, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that execution of the Exhibit A agreement is in the best interest of the Village,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Mayor, Administrator and Clerk are authorized to execute the Exhibit A agreement with H.R. Green.

SECTION TWO: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
