

RESOLUTION NO. 22-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN FEES FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THE CAMP CRAYON PRESCHOOL PROGRAM AND APPROVING A NEW SCHEDULE OF FEES

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch, County of Lake, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor (the "Mayor") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Board") together with the Mayor constitute, the "Corporate Authorities") adopted Title 8, Chapter 4, Section 5 of the Village Code of Ordinances (the "Ordinance") requiring participants in programs or users of facilities operated by the Department of Parks and Recreation (the "Department") to pay fees set by the Department and approved by the Corporate Authorities, and are shown on a fee schedule posted in the Department's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Park Commission of the Village (the "Commission"), has determined that the fees for participants in the Camp Crayon Preschool Program (the "Program") should be increased by five percent (5%), starting with the first day of the 2022-2023 school year and increasing by five percent (5%) on the first day of each school year thereafter until the minimum wage has reached fifteen dollars (\$15), which is projected to occur in 2025, and then increasing by three percent (3%) for each school year thereafter (the "Fee Increase"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission has recommended that the Corporate Authorities approve the Fee Increase to offset the increase in operating costs associated with the Program and adopt the Schedule of Fees for the Program shown in the attached Exhibit A of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have considered the Commission's recommendation along with other relevant information and determined that it is in the best interests of the Village adopt the recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Incorporation. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that the recitals hereinbefore stated in the preamble to this Resolution are full, true, and correct and are hereby, by reference, incorporated and made a part of this Resolution as legislative findings.

SECTION TWO. Purpose. The purpose of this Resolution is to authorize an increase in fees for the Program, to adopt a new Schedule of Fees, which is shown in Exhibit A of this Resolution and to ratify any steps taken to effectuate those goals.

SECTION THREE. Authority. This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

SECTION FOUR. Authorization. The proposed increase in fees for use of the Center and the new Schedule of Fees shown in Exhibit A of this Resolution are hereby approved. The Village Board ratifies any previous action taken to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. The Village Board further authorizes and directs the Mayor or his designee to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION FIVE. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution is held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

SECTION SIX. Superseder. Any resolution or portion of any resolution in conflict with any provisions of this Resolution is hereby repealed solely to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION SEVEN. Publication. A full, true, and complete copy of this Resolution shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION EIGHT. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by applicable law.

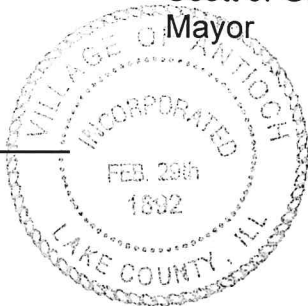
