A RESOLUTION APPROVING A BUSINESS INCENTIVE GRANT FOR COMMAND SERVICE CENTER FOR PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS 315 N. DEPOT STREET.

WHEREAS, the Village approved the Business Incentive Grant program in 2019 to provide matching funds to business owners who make new investment in their exteriors or interiors.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Business Incentive Grant Program is to promote new investment into existing and new businesses and improve the character of the Village's downtown and commercial corridors.

WHEREAS, the applicant operates a commercial business at the property commonly known as 315 N. Depot Street.

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements will increase the visibility of this building and assist the applicant's business.

WHEREAS, the Village Board was able to conclude that the applicant's request met several factors for the Business Incentive Program and the assistance was justified in order to allow the applicant to remain a viable business in the Village of Antioch.
