

Antioch Police and Fire Commission

Meeting Minutes

June 30, 2017

I. Call to order

A meeting of the Police and Fire Commission was called to order on June 30, 2017 at 4:00 PM by Commissioner Jim Kinney and seconded by Commissioner William Zeason at the State Bank of The Lakes.

II. Roll Call

Antioch Police Commission conducted a roll call. The following persons were present: Jim Kinney, William Zeason, and Jenny Olsen.

III. Old Business

a. Initial Eligibility Roster

1. Review of background checks for Initial Hire Candidates: Background checks for candidates 6, 7, 8 and 9 were reviewed by the commission.

1. A motion was made by Commissioner Zeason and seconded by Commissioner Kinney to reject candidate 6, Evan Swanson based on the results of the background check. Motion passed with a majority "yes" vote.
2. A motion was made by Commissioner Kinney and seconded by Commissioner Zeason to reject candidate 7, Zachary Galuski based on the results of the background check. Motion passed with a majority "yes" vote.
3. A motion was made by Commissioner Kinney and seconded by Commissioner Zeason to extend an offer of conditional employment, subject to Psych, Poly and Physical testing to candidate 8, Andrew Belanger. Motion passed with a majority "yes" vote.
4. A motion was made by Commissioner Kinney and seconded by Commissioner Zeason to extend an offer of conditional employment, subject to Psych, Poly and Physical testing to candidate 9, Jacob Palak. Motion passed with a majority "yes" vote.

It was noted that the top 9 candidates on the Initial Eligibility Roster have been address and we are now down to candidate #10.
