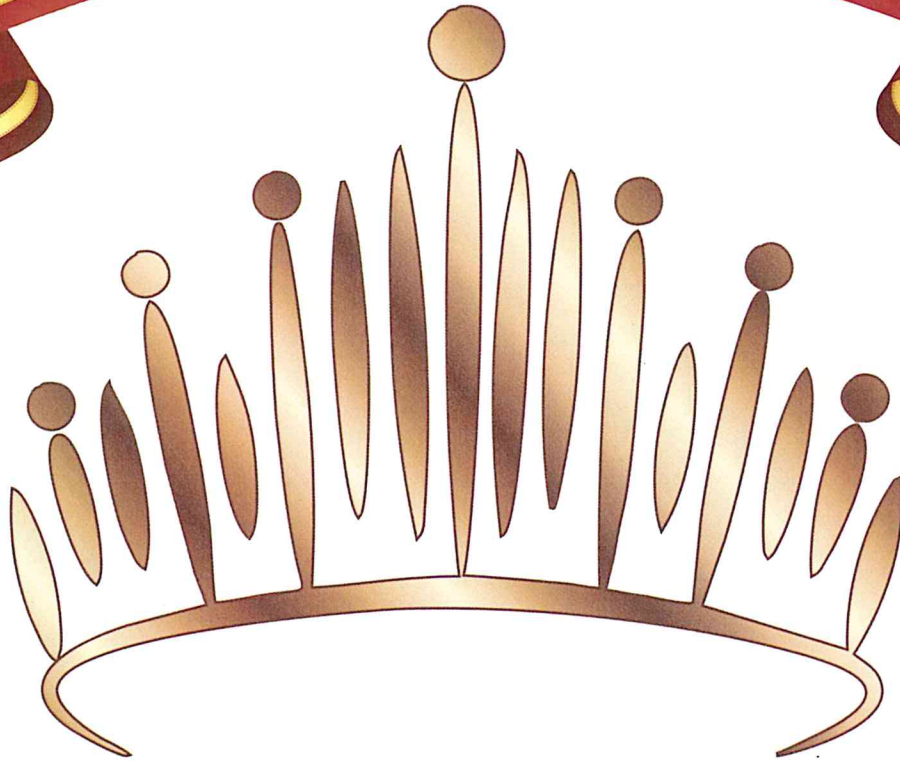

2018 Miss Antioch Pageant Rules

1. **Must be a United States Citizen and never been convicted of a felony offense.**
2. **Must be a female resident of Antioch (60002) for at least 60 days.**
3. **Must be at least 16 years old by June 16, 2018, and not reach her 22nd birthday by January 1st 2019.**
4. **Must be single and never married, had a marriage annulled or been pregnant.**
5. **Must not have been disqualified in any previous Village of Antioch Pageant or had her title revoked for any reason whatsoever. Must not have had a sibling disqualified in any previous Village of Antioch Pageant or had her title revoked for any reason whatsoever.**
6. **Must not have previously held the Miss Antioch title and is not currently holding another title at the time of the 2018 Miss Antioch Pageant. For clarification purposes, holding a current title from another pageant means that you have entered and won a pageant within the year, and hold a title and sash which designates you as a winner of that particular pageant. A preliminary pageant winner does not hold a title. You may however enter and win the Miss Lake County Illinois State Pageant and keep your title as Miss Antioch. You would then be known as Miss Lake County from Antioch.**
7. **Must agree that the time, manner and method of conducting the pageant shall be established by the Pageant Director.**
8. **Must agree to appear on stage in a formal-floor length evening gown, athletic wear outfit, and "Business/Interview Wear". Must agree to attend all practice sessions and meetings prior to the pageant. If unable to do so, must arrange time with the Pageant Director to compensate. The current scoring system gives 35 points for Personal Interview, 25 points for Speech and Communication Skills (45-60 second speech about your platform - something important to you, as long as it is not immoral, political or controversial), 20 points for Stage Presence (Evening Gown), and 20 points for Beauty of Face and Physical Condition (Athletic Wear).**
9. **Must turn in completed application, \$50.00 fee (if submitted by 3/5) or \$60 fee (submitted between 3/6-4/13), and picture by 5:00 p.m. on April 13th, 2018. This includes a shirt/tank top from the Village of Antioch Pageant as well as workshops and practices!**
10. **Must agree to refer all appearance requests to the Pageant Director for approval and abide by their decision.**
11. **If chosen Miss Antioch you must agree to represent Antioch with the utmost dignity and grace. That presentation will include, It's Thursday Concerts, 4th of July Festivities, Pancake Breakfast, Lions Club Chicken BBQ, Homecoming Parade, Christmas Parade and many more functions that may arise.**
12. **If chosen Miss Antioch you must complete a minimum of one event supporting your platform and charity. The pageant director will assist you with this and the planning.**
13. **If chosen as Miss Antioch you must agree to compete in the Lake County Illinois State Pageant, (LCIS) in 2019 representing Antioch on March 4, 2018.**
14. **Should the Queen marry, become pregnant, move out of Antioch, or in any way become ineligible, she must immediately relinquish her title to the next eligible runner-up. This provision will be administered with the utmost integrity and sensitivity by the Pageant Committee/Park Board Commission.**

15. **The judges' decisions are final. All judges are non-biased, not paid and are selected based on their qualifications and have no association with Antioch. Judges scores are done individually and they do not know how the other judges are scoring and do not know who the winner is until all tabulations are done and the winner is announced. Tabulators are Antioch Park Board Commission Members or Village Employees and all score totals are checked 2 ways. Scoring sheets are kept confidential and destroyed after the pageant. This includes but not limited to the Community Choice Winner, Winners of each division as well as runners-up in each category.**
16. **We expect that you and your family and friends will show good sportsmanship before, during and after the pageant. Do not confront the judges, tabulators or pageant committee after the pageant with questions on scoring. If this policy is not adhered to, we reserve the right to refuse you and your siblings applications in future pageants.**
17. **The Pageant, and the responsibilities attendant to it, does not end with the crowning of Miss Antioch. Rather, the responsibilities and the Pageant rules commence with the submission of the application and continue in effect throughout the entire term of the winner's title. Any display of bad sportsmanship or confrontations of other entrants or village personnel during the entire term will subject the title-holder to discipline, up to and including revocation of her title and disqualification of her and her siblings from any future competitions or titles. Any acts of the family and friends of the Pageant participant can and will be considered to be acts of the participant. Furthermore, if you cannot fulfill the expressed duties, violate any rule set forth, or conduct yourself in a manner unbecoming of a queen and representative of the Village of Antioch, you will immediately relinquish your title, crown, sash, and all prizes upon the direction of the Antioch Pageant Director. The 1st runner up will then be eligible for the title.**
18. **Along with the prize package from area businesses, Miss Antioch will also be awarded scholarship money to the college of her choice at the end of her reign, should the queen become ineligible to continue her reign for any reason, the scholarship will be awarded to the 1st runner up.**
19. **The Village of Antioch does not recognize any other pageant title at Antioch events other than titles given through the Lake County Faire & Lake County Illinois State Pageant System.**
20. **The official application form must be used and the answers must be limited to the space provided on the application. Do not add pages, lines, etc. so that all girls have the same advantage when the judges are viewing their applications. We reserve the right to refuse applications if this rule is not adhered to. Applications must be filled out by the contestant in her own words.**
21. **The Community Choice Winner is picked as followed; Each division will have a winner. Winner is selected ONLY by the amount of CASH donation in the contestants containers at the pageant. Checks, Written Notes, Gift Cards or any other donation of any kind WILL NOT be counted. Furthermore, any donations picked up on behalf of the pageant MUST be cleared by the director PRIOR to soliciting any businesses – this is a job that is done by the current queens, pageant committee and the director and we do not want to be asking businesses more than once for donations.**
22. **Best Smile Contest is picked as followed; Each division will have a winner; the winner is selected by the additional 5 x 7 headshot photograph they submit at the time of their application. The staff at Antioch Dental and the Staff at the Village Hall will vote on the best smile. Plaques and prizes will be presented on stage before the crowning of each division of Miss Antioch, Jr. Miss Antioch and Little Miss Antioch.**

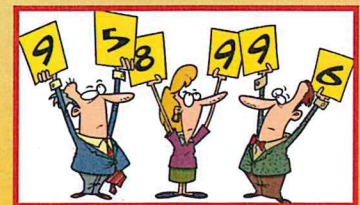

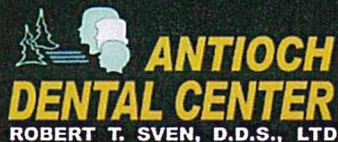
