Registration

Sign up for what you need, but you must register for a minimum of two days a week. **Registration closes** the Monday, one week before the start of the week you are registering for. If you need to register after the cut off day, there is a \$25 late registration fee.

Registration can be done online or in person. We do NOT register over the phone or take payments over phone.

Once registration has been processed, no changes/swapping days, can be made to that registration. Payment for each weekly session is due at the time of registration.

<u>Forms</u>

No camper will be accepted into camp without all forms completed and turned in. Forms can be found online at <u>www.antioch.il.gov</u> or on the band app

Below is the list of forms needed:

-Medical Consent (only if your child requires to carry medicine, epi-pen or inhaler)

Arrival and Departure

Parents must sign their child in and out each day. The counselors will have a clipboard for you to sign in and out. If you use early bird or extended day, your camper will be walked to their respective camp. Only persons listed on the camper information sheet will be allowed to sign out, please bring ID when signing out.

Late pick up- if you are late and your child is sent to Extended Day, you will be charged \$15 for that day.

Behavior

Children are entitled to a pleasant and harmonious environment at camp and setting guidelines for good behavior are a part of the system we must follow. The camp director will speak to you personally if there is an issue with your child. Please help your child understand that bad behavior will not be tolerated. If this behavior persists it will result in a write up.

Write Ups

First Write Up- Guardian will be called and the write up will need to be signed at pick up. A copy will be given.

Second Write Up- Guardian will be called and the write up will need to be signed at pick up. A copy will be given. The camper will not be allowed to camp their following day. A refund will not be given for this day. **Third Write Up**- Guardian will be called and the write up will need to be signed at pick up. A copy will be given. The camper will not be allowed to come back to camp. No refunds will be issued.

Day Camp Swim lessons

Kids attending day camp can register to take swimming lessons from the Antioch Aqua Center. You must register for the 8:20 am time slot. Day camp swim lesson registration starts April 1 at 9:00 am. Parents will drop children at swim lessons and day camp staff will pick them up and bring them to their camp.

Typical Day schedule

8:30-9:00 a.m. Parks Building/ Scout House for drop off

9:00-9:15 Walking to a local park (Parks vary each day)

9:15-10:45 Group time at the various parks, snack (applying sunscreen)

10:45- 11:00 am. Walking to Antioch Aqua Center

11:00 am- 12:30 pm Swim time at Antioch Aqua Center

12:30-1:30 pm Eating lunch under the pavilion next to the Antioch Aqua Center or, if raining, eating lunch

- at Parks Building/Scout House (applying sunscreen)
- 1:30 pm Walking to another park for new activity

2:00-3:15 Group time at park

3:15-3:30 Walking back to Parks Building/Scout House

3:30-4:00 Parks Building/ Scout House for pick up

Swim Test

All campers are swim tested either before or on their first day of camp. The swim test consists of the camper jumping into the pool, around 3 feet of water, and swimming for about 20 feet or so without touching the bottom. They are then assigned a wristband color (green, blue, yellow, or orange) based off their performance during the swim test and where they can swim in the pool area. Day camp swims at the pool every day from 11:00 am- 12:30 pm.

Cookout and Pizza Days

These days are completely optional for campers. Every Friday staff will grill out hamburgers/hotdogs and alternating days Domino's Pizza is available (please check camp calendar for those days). Your camper can get lunch for \$4 on these days. Cook out includes hamburger or two hotdogs and a bag of chips. Pizza day includes 2-4 slices of pizza. They will need to bring drinks and dessert.

Field Trips

Day camp will take by bus 5 field trips during the summer. See calendar for dates and locations. Campers should wear their camp shirt. The buses leave the Parks building by 9:30am on field trip days. Please do NOT send money with your child, we do not allow them to make purchases on trips. Send everything in their backpack you would on a typical day camp day. The buses generally return to the Parks Building by 3:30pm.
