Ordinance No. 10-01-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-2B-14 OF THE ANTIOCH MUNICIPAL CODE INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS "C" RETAIL PACKAGE SALES LIQUOR LICENSES FROM EIGHT (8) TO NINE (9) AND

AMENDING SECTION 14-2B-9 OF THE ANTIOCH MUNICIPAL CODE CORRECTING A TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Village Board of Trustees received a request from Walgreens Drugstore to be issued a Class "C" retail package sales liquor license; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have considered the request and find that the same is consistent with the spirit and intent of the Antioch Liquor Code, is reasonable and should be granted; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this request it is necessary to increase the number of class "C" liquor licenses to be issued from eight (8) to nine (9); and

WHEREAS, a typographical error was found in section 4-2B-9 of the Liquor Code which requires amendment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Illinois as follows:

<u>SECTION I:</u> Section 14-2B-14 of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended and it shall hereafter read as follows (additions <u>underlined</u>, deletions in <u>strikeout</u>):

4-2B-14: NUMBER OF LICENSES:

The following is the maximum number of licenses that may be issued for each class. These numbers may be amended only by the board of trustees:

<u>SECTION II:</u> Section 4-2B-9 of the Municipal Code of Antioch is hereby amended and it shall hereafter read as follows (additions <u>underlined</u>, deletions in <u>strikeout</u>):

4-2B-9: TERMS OF LICENSES:

All licenses issued pursuant to this chapter other than class G license are operative and valid, unless terminated, revoked, or suspended, for one year commencing on June 1 of each year and terminating on May 30 31 of that same year. The licenses that are excluded from the one year term are operative and valid for the period of time specified in the license.

SECTION III: Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action arising, acquired or existing under any act or ordinance or portion thereof hereby repealed or amended by this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right, claim, penalty or remedy of any character of the corporate authority existing on the effective date hereof be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION V: If any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this ordinance or application thereof to any person, firm, corporation, public agency or circumstance, shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, said judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons, firms, corporation, or circumstances, but shall be confined in its operation to the provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and to the person, firm, corporation, or circumstances involved. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the corporate authorities that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part thereof not been included

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.


