ORDINANCE NO. 10-12-28

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2010 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2011.

BE IT ORDAINED, By the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch in the County of Lake, State of Illinois as follows:

SECTION I: The following sum or sums, or so much thereof as shall be authorized by law, as heretofore appropriated for corporate purposes to be collected from taxes to be levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2010 and ending April 30, 2011 be and the same are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes of the said current year.

SECTION II: That the extended balances of any item or items levied in and by this Ordinance may be guaranteed in making up any deficiency in any items under the same general appropriation and levy for the same general purpose.

SECTION III: That the purposes for which said amounts were heretofore appropriated and are now hereby levied respectfully as follows:
