ORDINANCE NO. 11-12-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEVERAL SECTIONS OF TITLE 4 CHAPTER 2B OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH ADDING A CLASS H-1 LICENSE

WHEREAS, the Village Board has been petitioned by the owner and operator of an existing Class H licensee which wishes to add an outside service area in an area being substantially redeveloped and remodeled, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has considered the petition and has determined that the proposal is appropriate for the suggested location and type of business, and that the petitioner is an appropriate designated licensee, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board wishes to expand business opportunities wherever possible, for the overall benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of this Village, and

WHEREAS, this particular remodeling and redevelopment is a highly attractive amenity being added to the existing hotel business, which should assist the Village Board in improving the overall marketability of the Village and in attracting additional tourists and hotel guests,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 4-2B-10(H) of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

Class H: Hotel license. This license authorizes the sale of all types of alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises only. A class H license is available only to a motel or hotel with sixty five (65) rooms or more, which has meeting or banquet facilities seating not less than eighty five (85) guests, with a minimum square footage for those facilities of not less than one thousand seven hundred (1,700) square feet. A class H license allows for service at a bar, in a banquet facility or meeting room and to individual hotel rooms as delivered by room service.

1. Class H-1: Hotel outdoor cafe full service license. This license authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic liquors for consumption at an outdoor cafe accessory to a hotel that holds a class H license. This license requires the specific prior approval of the Antioch liquor control commissioner, who may establish standards for the service of alcoholic liquors at the outdoor cafe as a condition for issuance of this license.

SECTION TWO: Section 4-2B-14 of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended by revision of the chart of allowed liquor licenses to add one Class H-1 license.

SECTION THREE: Section 4-2B-11(A)(2) is hereby amended by the revision of the chart of license fees to add a Class H-1 license at an annual fee of \$250.00 for the year 2011 and \$500.00 for the years 2012 and thereafter.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
