ORDINANCE 13-06-11

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING GRANDE JAKES TO RELINQUISH ITS LIQUOR LICENSE AND ISSUING A NEW ONE TO GRANDE LETTY'S, WAIVING FEES

the Village Board has been petitioned by Letitia Rodriguez on behalf of her corporation known as WHEREAS. "Grande Lettys Corp.", and in her petition, she has advised the Village Board that Grande Letty's Corp. currently owns 50% of the stock in the corporation known as "Grande Jakes Corp.", and that she has been directly involved in the management of the restaurant known as Grande Jakes for a substantial period of time, and

Ms. Rodriguez has further advised the Board that Grande Lettys Corp. intends to purchase the WHEREAS, remaining 50% of the stock of Grande Jakes Corp. and take over operations of the said restaurant, and to accomplish that, she needs the liquor license to remain in effect following the transition, and

the Antioch Liquor Code provides that liquor licenses are decremented when relinquished and are WHEREAS, not transferrable as a matter of right, and

the Village Board has considered the application and has determined that the proposal is WHEREAS, appropriate for the suggested location and type of business, and it is an appropriate designated licensee, and

the Village Board wishes to expand business opportunities wherever possible, for the overall WHEREAS, benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of this Village, and

the Village Board further finds that waiving the fees for issuance of the license to Grande Lettys WHEREAS, Corp. is appropriate in view of the related nature of the transaction and in view of the very limited amount of time the existing license has been in effect,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

The Village Clerk, acting as the Secretary of the Local Liquor Commissioner is directed SECTION ONE: to revise the chart of allowed liquor licenses as necessary to allow Grande Jakes Corp. to relinquish its existing license and to reissue the same to Grande Lettys Corp.

The fees for issuance of the license to Grande Lettys Corp. are hereby waived, however SECTION TWO: the fees for fingerprinting and background checks are not waived.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and SECTION THREE: publication as required by law.
