AN ORDINANCE INITIATING THE SUBMISSION OF A PUBLIC QUESTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE TO IMPOSE A SPECIAL PROPERTY TAX TO PROVIDE AMBULANCE SERVICE

---

**Whereas,** the Village Board finds that it is in the Village citizen's best interests that the Village provide emergency ambulance service to or from points within or without the Village; and

**Whereas,** the Village Board finds that it will require additional revenue from a dedicated, consistent source to provide such ambulance service; and

**Whereas,** pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-5-7 the Village Board may seek voter approval to raise sufficient revenue to provide ambulance service; and

**Whereas,** pursuant to the requirements of Illinois Law, the Village of Antioch seeks to place on the November 4, 2014 ballot a public question to be considered by voters in the said Village regarding the authorization of such property tax;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS,** as follows:

**SECTION ONE.**      **RECITALS.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated as if fully set forth in this ordinance.

**SECTION TWO.**      **PUBLIC QUESTION ON PROPERTY TAX TO PROVIDE AMBULANCE SERVICE.** A public question shall be submitted to the voters of the Village of Antioch, County of Lake, State of Illinois, at the November 4, 2014 general election (or at the next available election permitted by general election law), as follows:

Shall the Village of Antioch levy a special tax at a rate not to exceed .25% of the value of all taxable property within the Village as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue for the purpose of providing an ambulance service?	<u>YES</u>	<u>NO</u>

**SECTION THREE.**      **FILING.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file the authorizing Ordinance and other related matters with the appropriate election officials in accordance with applicable law.

**SECTION FOUR.**      **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.



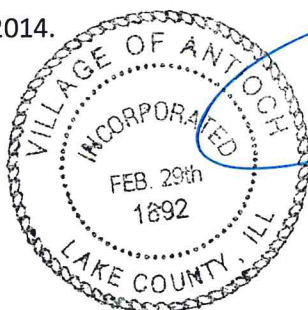
