ORDINANCE NO. 17-04-10

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING A PORTION OF ORCHARD STREET

WHEREAS, Orchard Street has long been a village street, and it originally ran westward from Main Street to a connection point with Lake Street after bending to the south, and

WHEREAS, Orchard Street was extended in 1995 eastward to a connection with Depot Street, and

WHEREAS, At the time Orchard Street was extended, the corporate authorities do not appear to have adopted an ordinance consistent with the provisions of the Plat Act (765 ILCS 205/9) which require the formal dedication of any new, extended or revised road, and

WHEREAS, recent work upon the extended Orchard Street brought this fact to the current administration's attention, as the repair of the culvert allowing Sequoit Creek to flow under Orchard Street required an exhaustive review of village documentation and the creation of new plats of survey showing the location of the improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board wishes to comply in all material respects with the provisions of applicable law and to properly dedicate roads as required,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That section of Orchard Street legally described on the attached Plat of Dedication is hereby dedicated to the public and it shall continue to be known as Orchard Street.

SECTION TWO: The Village Clerk is directed to record a copy of this Ordinance, together with the attached Plat of Dedication with the Lake County Recorder of Deeds and to take any other steps necessary to comply with the Plat Act.

SECTION THREE: The Community Development Director is directed to take any and all steps as may be necessary to ensure that all the official Village Maps include the proper location of the dedicated Orchard Street going forward.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
