ORDINANCE 17-09-33

AN ORDINANCE ADDING ONE CLASS E LIQUOR LICENSE, FOR ANTIOCH LANES LLC

WHEREAS, the Village Board has been petitioned by Jesse Wood and Mike Olsen, the owners of Antioch Lanes LLC who have purchased the property located at 750 Route 173, and in particular, the petition seeks an additional Class E liquor license which will allow them to operate a bar and tavern within the establishment, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has considered the petition and has determined that the proposal is appropriate for the suggested location and type of business, and that the petitioner is an appropriate designated licensee, having operated another bowling alley, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board wishes to expand business opportunities wherever possible, for the overall benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of this Village, particularly where the offerings of the proposed business are unique and aimed at a target market that will likely draw people into town,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Village Clerk, acting as the Secretary of the Local Liquor Commissioner is directed to revise the chart of allowed liquor licenses to increase the number of Class E licenses by 1, effective at such time as Antioch Lanes LLC has secured a certificate of occupancy, based upon completion of the Antioch Lanes conformance with all Village Codes, and it has further qualified for a Village of Antioch Liquor License.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
