**ORDINANCE 18-02-06**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-2B-10-B OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH MODIFYING THE CLASS "D" LICENSE REGULATIONS BY ALLOWING LIMITED SALES OF SPIRITS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has been petitioned by the owners of convenience store / gas stations seeking the opportunity to sell spirits in addition to their current packaged beer and wine offerings, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has considered the petition and has determined that the nature of the overall proposal is appropriate to add a reasonable opportunity for the sales of spirits, without allowing the wholesale conversion of gas stations and/or convenience stores into full liquor stores, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board wishes to expand business opportunities wherever possible, for the overall benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of this Village, while still retaining appropriate controls over sales to ensure a level playing field for competing commercial interests, and

**WHEREAS**, this particular proposal appears to be an appropriate offering to be added to the assets of the Village, which should assist the Village Board in improving the overall marketability of the Village and in attracting additional tourists and customers to local businesses,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Section 4-2B-10-B (D) of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended and it shall hereafter read as follows (additions underlined, deletions ~~stricken~~):

D. Class D: Gas station convenience store license. This license authorizes the retail sale of spirits, beer and wine in a gas station convenience store, in original package form, for consumption off the premises where sold. The amount of display floor space allowed for the sale of alcoholic beverages shall not exceed the greater of 33% of the space or 600 square feet.

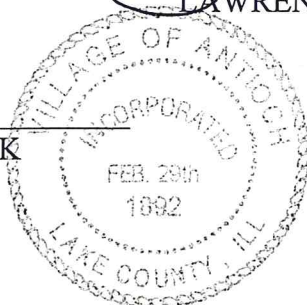
**SECTION TWO:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
