ORDINANCE 18-03-11

AN ORDINANCE ADDING ONE CLASS "A" RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JOHNNY'S CHOPHOUSE, LLC TO BE LOCATED AT 1500 MAIN STREET TO REFLECT A CHANGE IN CORPORATE OWNERSHIP AND PRO-RATING FEES

WHEREAS, the Village Board has been petitioned by Johnny's Chophouse, LLC who has announced their intention to operate Johnny's Chophouse at 1500 Main Street, and in particular, who has asked that they be granted an additional Class "A" liquor license which will allow them to conduct restaurant alcohol sales, and

WHEREAS, the Antioch Liquor Code provides that liquor licenses are decremented when relinquished and are not transferrable as a matter of right, and

WHEREAS, the previous owner, Peter Phillips of Johnny's Chophouse of Antioch Inc. relinquished his liquor license on March 4, 2018, whereupon the Clerk duly reduced the number of Class "A" liquor licenses in effect on the chart by one, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has considered the application and has determined that the proposal is appropriate for the suggested location and type of business, and it is an appropriate designated licensee, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board wishes to expand business and cultural opportunities wherever possible, for the overall benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of this Village,

WHEREAS, the Village Board further finds that prorating the fees for issuance of the license to Johnny's Chophouse, LLC is appropriate in view of the very limited amount of time remaining for this license year,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Village Clerk, acting as the Secretary of the Local Liquor Commissioner is directed to revise the chart of allowed liquor licenses to increase the number of Class A licenses by 1 effective at such time as Johnny's Chophouse, LLC has secured a certificate of occupancy for the proposed restaurant and qualified for a Village of Antioch Liquor License.

SECTION TWO: The fees for issuance of the liquor license to Johnny's Chophouse, LLC shall be prorated to the amount due of \$500 for the remainder of the current license year expiring May 31, 2018.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
