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## **ORDINANCE 18-03-12**

### **AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING DNAA LLC dba WINGS ETC. TO RELINQUISH ITS LIQUOR LICENSE AND ISSUING A NEW ONE TO GAILBERT INC dba WINGS ETC GRILL & PUB, PRO-RATING FEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has been petitioned by Mciahel and Pamela Hasmann on behalf of thier corporation known as “Gailbert Inc.”, and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioners have advised the Board that Gailbert Inc. intends to purchase the establishment known as Wings Etc. and take over operations of the said restaurant under the same dba, and to accomplish that needs the liquor license to remain in effect following the transition, and

**WHEREAS**, the applicants have compelted a background check and investigation through the Antioch Police Department, who subsequently provided a report of their findings to the liquor commissioner, and

**WHEREAS**, the Antioch Liquor Code provides that liquor licenses are decremented when relinquished and are not transferrable as a matter of right, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has considered the application and has determined that the proposal is appropriate for the suggested location and type of business, and it is an appropriate designated licensee, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board wishes to expand business opportunities wherever possible, for the overall benefit of the citizens and taxpayers of this Village, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board further finds that prorating the fees for issuance of the license to Gailbert Inc. is appropriate in view of the very limited amount of time remaining for this license year,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** The Village Clerk, acting as the Secretary of the Local Liquor Commissioner is directed to revise the chart of allowed liquor licenses as necessary to allow DNAA LLC to relinquish its existing license and to reissue the same to Gailbert, Inc., once all necessary paperwork has been submitted and the applicants qualify for a license.

**SECTION TWO:** The fees for issuance of the liquor license to Gailbert Inc. shall be prorated to the amount due of \$500 for the remainder of the current license year expiring May 31, 2018.

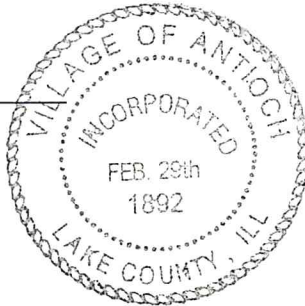
**SECTION THREE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
