ORDINANCE NUMBER 20-03-09

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF GROUNDWATER AS A POTABLE WATER SUPPLY BY THE INSTALLATION OR USE OF POTABLE WATER SUPPLY WELLS OR BY ANY OTHER METHOD

WHEREAS, certain properties in the Village of Antioch, Illinois have been used over a period of time for commercial/industrial purposes; and

WHEREAS, because of said use, concentrations of certain chemical constituents in the groundwater beneath the City may exceed Class I groundwater quality standards for potable resource groundwater as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 620 or Tier 1 remediation objectives as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 742; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch desires to limit potential threats to human health from groundwater contamination while facilitating the redevelopment and productive use of properties that are the source of said chemical constituents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Use of groundwater as a potable water supply prohibited.

On or after the effective date of this Ordinance, the use or attempt to use as a potable water supply groundwater from within the area described below and depicted on Figure 9-1, attached hereto and incorporated herein, as the Restricted Groundwater Zone, within the corporate limits of the Village of Antioch, by the installation or drilling of wells or by any other method is hereby prohibited. This prohibition expressly includes the Village of Antioch.

The following properties shall be designated as the Restricted Groundwater Zone:

Section Two. Penalties.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine pursuant to Village Code 1-3-1 for each violation.

Section Three. Definitions.

“Person” is any individual, partnership, co-partnership, firm, company, limited liability company, corporation, association, joint stock company, trust, estate, political subdivision, or any other legal entity, or their legal representatives, agents or assigns.

“Potable water” is any water used for human or domestic consumption, including, but not limited to, water used for drinking, bathing, swimming, washing dishes, or preparing foods.

Section Four. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are in conflict with this ordinance.

Section Five. Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or under any circumstances is adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or of any portion not adjudged invalid.

Section Six. Effective date.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

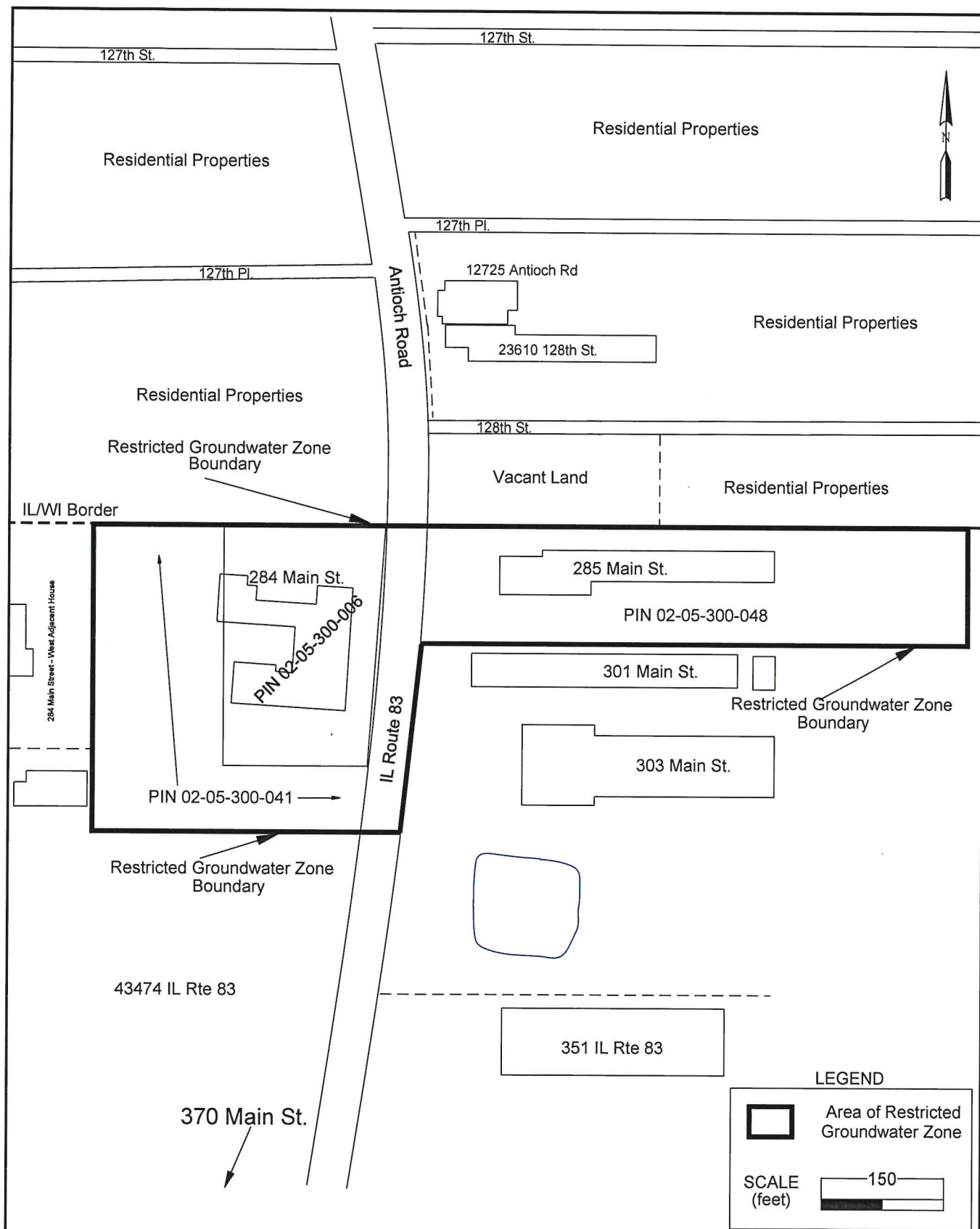
