## ORDINANCE 20-06-19

### ORDINANCE RESTORING BOARD APPROVALS FOR CLASS J LICENSES

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board recently adopted Ordinance 20-05-17 which made a number of modifications to the Antioch Liquor Code, Chapter 4-2A of the Municipal Code of the Village of Antioch, and

**WHEREAS**, in the drafting of that Ordinance a provision was included which removed the requirement that so-called BYOB (Class J) licenses all be approved by the Village Board individually, and

**WHEREAS**, during the discussion of the Ordinance aforesaid, the Village Board reached a preliminary determination that the removal of this requirement was inappropriate and should be reversed, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board finds and declares that it is sound public policy to vet all BYOB applications individually and not leave them up to the Liquor Commissioner to issue at his or her discretion, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village Board of the Village of Antioch, Illinois as follows:

**Section One:** Section 4-2B-10(J) is amended by the addition of the following subparagraph f which shall hereafter read as follows:

#### 4-2B-10(J)

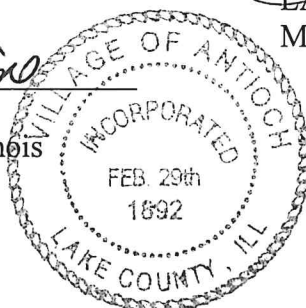
- f. Each application shall be reviewed by the village board of trustees and either approved or denied by a majority vote.


**Section Two:** This amendatory ordinance is intended as a severable ordinance, and if it, or any provision hereof, is found to be unenforceable by any court for any reason, such partial or complete invalidity shall not affect the balance of the Antioch Liquor Code which shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section Three:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, approval, and publication pursuant to law.
