Ordinance No. 21-08-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH REGARDING GENERAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch ("Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1, et seq.) (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Village Board of Trustees (the "Village Board", and together with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Title 7, Chapter 1 of the Municipal Code of Antioch (the "Village Code") sets forth certain general traffic regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that certain regulations regarding automobile displays of power need to be created in order to further promote the health, safety, and welfare of the Village's residents; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village, and its residents, to amend Title 7, Chapter 1 of the Village Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution, or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Title 7, Chapter 1, of the Village Code as set forth below (additions <u>underlined</u>):

ARTICLE C. DISPLAY OF POWER RESTRICTIONS

7-1C-1: PROHIBITION:

No person shall make unnecessary noises with a motor vehicle by squealing tires, excessive acceleration or revving of engine or by emitting unnecessary and loud muffler noises or exhaust smoke, which unreasonably disturbs the peace, quiet, and comfort of pedestrians, individuals on sidewalks, neighbors and passers-by or is plainly audible at a distance of seventy-five (75) feet from any person in a commercial, residential, retail, or public space.

7-1C-2: PENALTY:

- A. Whoever violates any provision of this article shall be fined as provided in subsection 1-3-1A of this code for each offense.
- B. Whoever violates any provision of this article and such violation occurs during a vehicular collision shall be fined as provided in subsection 1-3-1A of this code for each such offense.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the amendment of Title 7, Chapter 1, of the Village Code.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: All ordinances, resolutions and orders or parts of ordinances, resolutions and orders in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after passage and publication as provided by law.
