Ordinance No. 21-09-35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-3-6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH REGARDING RESTRICTED PARKING

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch ("Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1, et seq.) (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Village Board of Trustees (the "Village Board", and together with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Section 7-3-6 of the Municipal Code of Antioch (the "Village Code") regulates restricted parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Village's regulations regarding restricted parking areas are outdated; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to eliminate stopping, standing, or parking by a vehicle on either side of Victoria Street, between Harden Street to the north and Harden Street to the south and within thirty (30) feet of an intersection; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village, and its residents, to amend Section 7-3-6 of the Village Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution, or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Title 7, Chapter 3, Section 7-3-6 of the Village Code as set forth below (additions <u>underlined</u>; deletions <u>stricken</u>):

7-3-6: RESTRICTED PARKING:

- A. There shall be a maximum of two (2) hour parking along the north side of Ida Street from eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. to four o'clock (4:00) P.M., Monday through Friday.
- B. There shall be no parking on the south side of Depot Street, between Pickard Avenue and Route 83 (Main Street) between the hours of eight thirty o'clock (8:30) A.M. and nine thirty o'clock (9:30) A.M., eleven thirty o'clock (11:30) A.M. to twelve thirty o'clock (12:30) P.M. or three o'clock (3:00) P.M. to four o'clock (4:00) P.M., Monday through Friday.
- C. There shall be a maximum four (4) hour parking limitation along the east side of Spafford Street.
- D. There shall be a maximum ten (10) minute parking limitation along the east side of Victoria Street in front of the commercial building located at 957 Victoria Street.
- E. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle on either side of Cameron Drive from Tiffany Farms Road to the end of Cameron Drive between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. and four o'clock (4:00) P.M., Monday through Friday.

- F. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle along the west side of McMillen Road from Route 173 to the end of the curve across from 67 McMillen Road at any time.
- G. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle along the east side of Hillside Avenue from Crest Lane north to Blackmann Terrace.
- H. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle on the south side of Heron Drive from Route 59 west to the driveway of 1452 Heron Drive and on the north side of Heron Drive from Route 59 west to the driveway of 1451 Heron Drive.
- I. It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle on either side of Victoria Street, between Harden Street to the north and Harden Street to the south.
- J. <u>It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop, stand or park such vehicle within thirty feet (30') of an intersection.</u>

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the amendment of Title 7, Chapter 3, Section 7-3-6 of the Village Code.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: All ordinances, resolutions and orders or parts of ordinances, resolutions and orders in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after passage and publication as provided by law.
