**ORDINANCE 21-10-37**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ISSUANCE OF A CLASS J  
BYOB LICENSE TO ANTIOCH FINE ARTS FOUNDATION**

**WHEREAS**, Antioch Fine Arts Foundation (“Petitioner”) is an art gallery, community, and not-for-profit organization currently operating in good standing and is located at 952 Main Street within the Village of Antioch, and;

**WHEREAS**, Petitioner has filed an application seeking a Class J BYOB license with the Village Clerk, which application complies with all requirements of Section 4-2B-10(J) of the Antioch Municipal Code, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has allowed the Petitioner to present its petition in the Committee of the Whole held on October 13, 2021, and is fully informed of the representations made by the Petitioner as to the intentions of the business to comply in all material respects with the business management aspects and limitations described in Section 4-2B-10(J), and being otherwise fully informed in the premises, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board finds that the Petitioner has presented a petition which can reasonably be expected to expand the entertainment opportunities available to the public without introducing additional burdens on law enforcement or other municipal services, and as such should be approved;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:


**SECTION ONE:** The Village Clerk is directed to prepare appropriate documentation to issue a Class J license to Petitioner, Antioch Fine Arts Foundation.

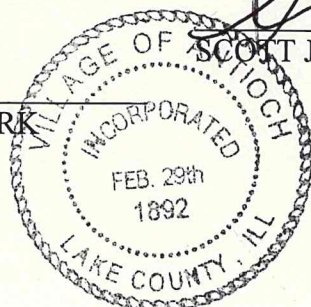
**SECTION TWO:** The Mayor, in his capacity as Local Liquor Commissioner, is authorized to execute the foregoing Class J License and to issue the same to the Peitioner upon payment of the scheduled fees and compliance of the Petitioner with any remaining documentation required by the Code.

**SECTION THREE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
