Ordinance No. 21-11-43

***AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH AND THE STORMWATER
MANAGEMENT COMMISSION OF LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS***

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch (“Village”) is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1, *et seq.*) (the “Code”); and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the “President”) and the Village Board of Trustees (the “Village Board”, and together with the President, the “Corporate Authorities”) are committed to promoting, protecting and preserving the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*) provides, in pertinent part, that any one or more public agencies may contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking or to combine, transfer, or exercise any powers, functions, privileges, or authority which any of the public agencies entering into the contract is authorized by law to perform, provided that the governing bodies of each party to the contract approves such contract; and

WHEREAS, the Village and the Stormwater Management District of Lake County, Illinois (the “Commission”) want to undertake capital projects designed to preserve floodplains; reduce flood peaks and runoff volumes; improve and maintain drainage systems; and protect property and critical facilities in flood hazard areas; and

WHEREAS, the Sequoit Creek Daylighting and Flood Mitigation Project (“Project”) will assist in reducing or eliminating flood hazards along the daylighted creek reach of the Sequoit Creek located in the Village; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A is a copy of an intergovernmental agreement, which sets forth the terms and conditions under which the Village and the Commission will utilize and share the cost of the Project (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village, and its residents, to approve and enter into the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the President, or his designee, to enter into and approve the Agreement in accordance with its terms, or any modification thereof, and to ratify any and all previous action taken to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance. The Corporate Authorities hereby further authorize and direct the President, or his designee, to perform all necessary acts to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance and to authorize and direct the expenditure of all costs related thereto or resulting therefrom.

SECTION 2: All ordinances, resolutions and orders or parts of ordinances, resolutions and orders in conflict with this Ordinance are superseded to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: The Village Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and publication as provided by law.



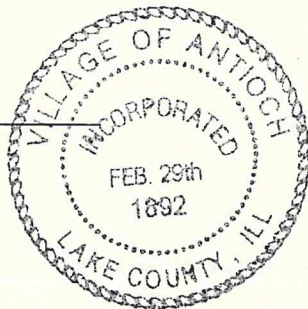
