Ordinance No. 22-01-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-5-10 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH REGARDING THE DEPUTY LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch ("Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1, et seq.) (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor (the "Mayor") and the Village Board of Trustees (the "Village Board", and together with the Mayor, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Section 1-5-10 of the Municipal Code of Antioch (the "Village Code") allows for the mayor to appoint a deputy local liquor control commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Village's regulations regarding the deputy local liquor control commissioner require an update; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to amend the title, duties, and compensation of the deputy local liquor control commissioner; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village, and its residents, to amend Section 1-5-10 of the Village Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution, or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Title 1, Chapter 5, Article Section 1-5-10 of the Village Code as set forth below (additions <u>underlined</u>; deletions <u>stricken</u>):

1-5-10: ASSISTANT DEPUTY LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSIONER:

- A. Conditions Of Office: The assistant deputy local liquor control commissioner shall function without remuneration. If, for any reason, the reappointment should not take place, the sitting assistant deputy commissioner shall act until a new appointment is made by the mayor with the advice and consent of the Village Board.
- B. Duties: The duties of the assistant deputy local liquor control commissioner shall be to act on behalf of and at the request of the commissioner or in the absence of the commissioner and shall be empowered with the same duties and functions of the commissioner, which shall include but not be limited to attending all hearings, enforcing all requirements of the Village Code and licenses and to-performing all

of the other duties incidental to the position of local liquor control commissioner. (1976 Code § 31.105)

- C. Hearings: All hearings regarding licenses and related matters shall be held at the Village Hall and shall be open to the public and be held in accordance with other such rules as established in the Village Code or in other provisions of applicable law.
- D. Compensation: The deputy local liquor control commissioner shall receive such compensation as the Village Board shall fix from time to time by ordinance or resolution.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the amendment of Title 1, Chapter 5, Article Section 1-5-10 of the Village Code.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: All ordinances, resolutions and orders or parts of ordinances, resolutions and orders in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and publication and at the earliest time as provided by law.
