**Ordinance No. 22-02-07**

***AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-2C-4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH REGARDING HOURS OF BUSINESS FOR ESTABLISHMENTS WHICH SELL ALCOHOL***

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Antioch ("Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1, et seq.) (the "Code"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President (the "President") and the Village Board of Trustees (the "Village Board", and together with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-2C-4 of the Municipal Code of Antioch (the "Village Code") regulates the hours of business for establishments which sell alcohol; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Village's regulations regarding the hours of business for establishments which sell alcohol require an update; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities desire to amend the business hours for those establishments which sell alcohol for consumption on the premises; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village, and its residents, to amend Section 4-2C-4 of the Village Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution, or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Title 4, Chapter 2, Article Section 4-2C-4 of the Village Code as set forth below (additions underlined; deletions ~~stricken~~):

**4-2C-4: HOURS OF BUSINESS:**

A. Consumption on the Premises: Persons or businesses holding a license allowing for on premises consumption of alcohol shall not sell, permit to be sold, give away or allow to be consumed any alcoholic beverage for consumption between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on weekdays, and between 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on Saturdays and Sundays, and New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day. It shall be unlawful to serve or to consume alcoholic liquor in, or to admit the public to, any premises in or on which alcoholic liquors are sold at retail during the hours within which the sale of such alcoholic liquors is prohibited. Other business or social functions of restaurant, club, hotel, and motel establishments may continue beyond such hours, provided that no alcoholic liquors are sold to, offered for sale to, served to or consumed by the public, patrons, employees, or membership during such hours.- It is unlawful to have licensed premises open for business or to admit the public to such premises during the hours within which the sale of alcoholic liquors is prohibited. Sale hours for outdoor cafes are provided in subsections 4-2C-5I and 4-2C-6I of this article. ~~Consumption On The Premises: It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor for consumption on any premises in the village except between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. and two o'clock (2:00) A.M. the following morning on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday; and it shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor for consumption on any premises in the village except between the hours of~~



~~seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and three o'clock (3:00) A.M. the following morning on any Friday, Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday. It shall be unlawful to serve or to consume alcoholic liquor in, or to admit the public to, any premises in or on which alcoholic liquors are sold at retail during the hours within which the sale of such alcoholic liquors is prohibited. Other business or social functions of restaurant, club, hotel and motel establishments may continue beyond such hours, provided that no alcoholic liquors are sold to, offered for sale to, served to or consumed by the public, patrons, employees or membership during such hours. Sale hours for outdoor cafes are provided in subsections 4-2C-5I and 4-2C-6I of this article.~~

~~The hours applicable to legal holidays as set forth hereinabove shall further apply to the following days: July 3 and the Wednesday immediately before Thanksgiving.~~

B. Consumption Off the Premises: It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in its original package for consumption off the premises in the village between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on weekdays and between 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. ~~except between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) A.M. and twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight on any day.~~ Other business functions, such as retail sales of other products at any store or gas station convenience store may continue during hours that alcohol sales are prohibited.

C. Service During Restaurant Operation: In restaurants with class A or class B licenses, it shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale or dispense any alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises at any time when the food service operations of the restaurant are not operating.

SECTION 2: The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the amendment of Title 4, Chapter 2, Article Section 4-2C-4 of the Village Code.

SECTION 3: All ordinances, resolutions and orders or parts of ordinances, resolutions and orders in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after passage and publication as provided by law.

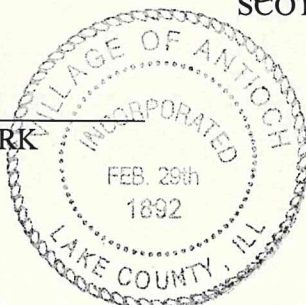
