Ordinance No. 22-03-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-2C-14 OF THE ANTIOCH VILLAGE CODE DECREASING THE MINIMUM AGE LIMITATION FOR SELLING PACKAGED ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN CERTAIN LICENSED PREMISES FROM THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS TO THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch ("Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Village Board of Trustees (the "Village Board" and together with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to promoting, protecting, and preserving the health, safety, and welfare of its residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2C-14 of the Antioch Village Code (the "Village Code") sets forth the rules and regulations for the sale of alcoholic liquor within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 4-2C-14(C) of the Village Code imposes a minimum age requirement of twenty-one (21) years for any person to sell packaged alcoholic liquors at a licensed premises in the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4-1 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934 (235 ILCS 5/4-1) the Corporate Authorities have the power to establish regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of and operations under local licenses not inconsistent with law as the public good and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that the Village's age limitation should be decreased to the age of eighteen (18) years to help the owners of these businesses find new employees; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village, and its residents, to amend Section 4-2C-14 of the Village Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution, or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Title 4, Chapter 2, Article C, Section 4-2C-14 of the Village Code as set forth below (additions <u>underlined</u>; deletions <u>stricken</u>):

4-2C-14: PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE YEARS IN LICENSED PREMISES OR MIXING DRINKS:

C. Package Sales Limitations: It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty one (21) eighteen (18) years to sell packaged alcoholic liquors to any person. This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, ringing or scanning transactions at a retail store's cash register.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Corporate Authorities hereby approve the amendment of Title 4, Chapter 2, Article C, Section 4-2C-14 of the Village Code.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: All ordinances, resolutions and orders or parts of ordinances, resolutions and orders in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

 $\underline{\sf SECTION}$ 4: The Village Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after passage and publication as provided by law.
