



# PRESCHOOL



## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Child must be toilet trained
- \$50 non-refundable registration fee
- Copy of original Birth Certificate
- Completed Student information form
- Physical Form (Illinois DHS Certificate of Child Health)

Recognizing that play is a very important aspect of a child's development, the Camp Crayon Preschool is based on the concept of learning through play and simple structured activities.

Our program is a social program for 2, 3, 4, and 5 year olds. It is often a child's first experience away from the home environment. The children in our program will be provided with the opportunity to develop emotional, social, physical and intellectual skills through a variety of creative and fun learning activities.

Classes will begin in September and will run through mid May. To be considered for registration, children must be the correct age by September 1, 2020. There is a maximum of 20 children per class.

The teacher to student ratio is 1:7.
