#### **NEW THIS YEAR!**

#### Register for the whole summer and pay weekly.

**Resident Registration starts March 1** 

#### Non-Resident Registration starts April 1

You can register for the hole or half the summer upfront and choose the pay later option. You will pay 25% of each weeks amount and then your credit card will be charged the remaining amount on that Monday before the week you are registered for. Once you have registered there are no changes allowed to your registration, no switching days, cancelling days etc. Registration closes Monday at 11:59pm before the following week. If you miss the registration deadline there is an automatic \$25 late fee added to your account when registering late.

#### **DAY CAMP SWIM TEST**

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

Recognizing that play is a very important aspect of a child's development, the Camp Crayon Preschool is based on the concept of learning through play and simple structured activities. Our program is a social program for 2, 3, 4 and 5 year olds. It is often a child's first experience away from the home environment. The children in our program will be provided with the opportunity to develop emotional, social, physical and intellectual skills through a variety of creative and fun learning activities.

#### GENERAL POOL INFORMATION

A child not toilet-trained MUST wear a re-usable agua diaper at all times. Agua diapers have a tight fitting plastic or rubber pant that is fitted around the legs and waist. Disposable diapers, such as Little Huggies, are only allowed when covered by the tight fitting aqua diaper or suit. Aqua diapers are reusable and should be worn over a regular diaper. Children without appropriate diapers are not allowed in the pool.

US Coast Guard approved lifejackets are allowed in the pool. No other flotation devices are allowed. This includes water wings, noodles, inner tubes, un-approved lifejackets, etc.

\*\*\*The Agua Center has a limited number of approved lifejackets available for use free of charge with a secured ID.

Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies. All non-swimmers should remain within an arm's length of a responsible adult at all times.

Children age 11 and under are not permitted in the facility unless accompanied by an individual over 16 years of

Lounge and deck chairs are for ages 16 years and older.

Coolers and food are not allowed into the facility.

No glass containers or controlled substances are allowed. This includes baby food in glass containers.

Safety breaks will be announced at designated times. Adults and infants, who cannot walk on their own, will be allowed in the water during safety breaks. Children must be held at all times. Slides are only open to adults during safety breaks.

No smoking inside the facility or within 15 feet of entrance. Please dispose of cigarettes in the proper containers on-site.

No gum allowed in the facility.

Additional facility rules are posted at the Agua Center.

#### ANTIOCH WAVES SWIM TEAM

All swimmers must be able to swim, any stroke, one length of the pool (25 meters). Swim team practices will spotlight continued development of all four strokes (freestyle, back, breast and butterfly) as well as diving and turns. There will be a focus on technique and endurance. All swimmers are eligible to compete in up to five swim meets during the season. #### **SWIM LESSON LEVELS**

#### PRESCHOOL - Ages 3-5 years

The class is a water acclimation class where children will learn to separate from parents, blow bubbles, become comfortable in the water and much more.

#### LEVEL 1- Ages 4 and up

This class is for children who have already mastered the skills learned in preschool and are ready to progress to underwater exploration, floating, kicking and forward movement in the water.

#### LEVEL 2- Ages 5 and up

Level 2 is for children who already can float on their front and back, understand movement in the water using various methods and are ready to begin rhythmic breathing.

#### LEVEL 3- Ages 6 and up

In this class your child will perfect the front and back crawl. They will learn the elementary backstroke, Whip kick and dolphin kicks along with treading.

#### LEVEL 4- Ages 6 and up

The concentration in this level will be on refinement of the above strokes, learning the butterfly, breast stroke and sidestroke, along with dives and turns.

#### LEVEL 5- Ages 6 and up

Level 5 refines all strokes, works on endurance building, surface dives and lifesaving skills.

#### DIVING - Ages 5 and up

This is a beginner to intermediate class where the child is expected to know how to swim in deep water. Students must be comfortable going headfirst off the side of the pool. Proper approach, standing dive, tuck, pike and back dives will be introduced.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Swim lessons WILL be held if it is raining or cold. Classes will only be canceled for lightning, tornado warnings or severe weather. Please call the Aquatic Center at 847-395 POOL for updates.

If lessons are canceled by us due to weather we will hold makeup lessons the following Friday at the same time.

Classes with low enrollment may be combined or canceled. If your child's class is canceled, you will receive a full refund.

#### REFUND POLICY

Refunds for Swim Lessons are issued according to the following auidelines:

- 100% refund if canceled more than two weeks before start of sessions.
- 50% refund if canceled less than two weeks before start of session.
- No refunds will be issued after you session has started. Scheduled classes that are missed cannot be made up at another time and will not receive a refund.
