SUBJECT: Consideration of an Ordinance Amending the Speed Limits Prescribed in section 7-3-13 of the Municipal Code of Antioch Relating to Harden Street and Hillside Avenue.

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

A petition has been presented to the Traffic Safety Committee regarding the posted speed limit signs, or lack thereof, on Hillside Avenue and Harden Street in between Route 59 and Route 173. The posted signage is 35 in one location and the ordinance allows 30 on both streets. The recommended speed limit on these streets per the committee is 25. The Village is allowed to change speed limits by ordinance in 5 mile per hour increments. Additional posted speed signs are proposed for entrances on Hillside and Harden from Route 59 and Route 173. This will have the effect to slow traffic and make speeding citations more enforceable.

ORDINANCE 18-02-xx

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SPEED LIMITS PRESCRIBED
IN SECTION 7-3-13 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ANTIOCH
RELATING TO HARDEN STREET AND HILLSIDE AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the provision of an adequate and safe street system is a core function of municipal government, and

WHEREAS, the setting of speed limits is necessary for allowing safe movement of vehicles, pedestrians and other traffic to, from and through all parts of the Village, and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities find that it is necessary to adopt revised speed limits on two Village roads so as to provide increased safety within the area served by those roads, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The table of speed limits set forth in Section 7-3-13 of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended and it shall hereafter provide that the speed limit for all sections of Harden Street shall be 25 miles per hour.

SECTION TWO: The table of speed limits set forth in Section 7-3-13 of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended and it shall hereafter provide that the speed limit for all sections of Hillside Avenue shall be 25 miles per hour.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
