**SUBJECT:** Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing the Village Administrator to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township to store the Village of Antioch's Vacuum (Vac) Truck at Fire Station #2 located at 700 Deep Lake Road Antioch, IL.

**SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:**

With the limited amount of space to store equipment at the Public Works Facility and the anticipated arrival of the Vac Truck, the First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township reached out to Public Works with available space. It is the Public Works desire to minimize outdoor exposure of valuable Village equipment.

It was entertained that storage at Station #2 is available in exchange for assistance with snow removal at Stations #1, 2 & 3. The snow will be removed as soon as practical and will not affect current snow removal operations for roadways.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE FIRST FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ANTIOCH TOWNSHIP TO STORE CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AT STATION 2**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Antioch Public Works Department is awaiting the delivery of a Vac Truck; and

**WHEREAS**, the First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township has available space to store equipment for the Village of Antioch at Station 2 located at 700 Deep Lake Road, Antioch IL; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village shall assist in snow removal at Stations #1, 2 & 3; and

**WHEREAS**, the snow will be removed as soon as practical and will not affect current snow removal operations

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, to authorize the Village Administrator to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township to store certain equipment at Station #2.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN  
THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH AND THE FIRST FIRE  
PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ANTIOCH TOWNSHIP

This Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2018 by and between the Village of Antioch, Illinois (VILLAGE) and the First Fire Protection District of Antioch Township (DISTRICT).

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has equipment and resources for snow removal and the DISTRICT requires assistance at their three Fire Stations with the timely removal of snow; and

WHEREAS; The VILLAGE needs a location to store certain equipment and DISTRICT available space at their Fire Station located at 700 Deep Lake Road, Antioch (STATION #2).

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual promises and obligations expressed herein and other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency, adequacy and receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT as follows:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Recitals The parties agree that the recitals have been incorporated by reference into the text of the Agreement as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. Snow Plowing The VILLAGE shall as soon as practical after each snow event, plow the driveway and parking lot at the DISTRICT's Stations #1,2 and 3.

SECTION 3. Equipment Storage The Village shall be allowed to store their Vac Truck at Station #2 at 700 deep lake Road, Antioch Il 60002. The Village shall maintain insurance on the Vac Truck.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Agreement pursuant to the ordinances or resolutions adopted by the relevant authorities of the respective parties
