SUBJECT: Approval of an Ordinance to Authorize the Village Administrator to sell, salvage or otherwise dispose of equipment.

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

In accordance with Chapter 65, Act 5 Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, the Village Board is being asked to approve an ordinance authorizing the Village Administrator to sell, salvage or dispose of equipment considered surplus personal property of the Village. These items have exceeded their useful life and are beyond economic repair and every effort will be made to sell the equipment.

The items to be sold or disposed of are listed in Exhibit A and attached to the ordinance.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SELL,

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch (“Village”) is a municipality located in Lake County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator would like to sell, salvage or dispose of vehicles, equipment or materials considered to be surplus property of the Village, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 65, Act 5 Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch find the property described in Exhibit “A” now owned by said jurisdiction is no longer useful to said jurisdiction and would be best served by the sale or disposal of the property, and

WHEREAS, the equipment to be sold or disposed of are beyond economic repair and every effort will be made to sell such equipment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Attached as “Exhibit A” is a list of items to be sold or disposed of.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
