SUBJECT: Consideration of adopting a Resolution regarding IDOT Permits for Construction on State Highway for Illinois Department of Transportation.

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

On January 22, 2019 a letter was received from Illinois Department of Transportation in regards to construction on state highways. Chapter 605 ILCS 5/4-208 and 5/9-113 of the Illinois Revised Statutes requires that any person, firm or corporation desiring to perform work in State rights of way must obtain a written permit from the Illinois Department of Transportation, including any emergency work on broken watermains or sewers. Adoption of the resolution for Construction on State Highway relieves a municipality from posting a surety bond with the State as long as work is performed by employees of the municipality. The resolution will be enacted for the period of two years. This procedure will save time and effort as well as reduce the annual paperwork associated with an annual resolution.

**REGARDING IDOT PERMITS FOR CONSTRUCTION
ON STATE HIGHWAY**

WHEREAS, the **Village of Antioch**, hereinafter referred to as Municipality, located in the County of Lake, State of Illinois, desires to undertake in the years 2019 and 2020, the location, construction, operation and maintenance of driveways and street returns, watermains, sanitary and storm sewers, street light, traffic signals, sidewalk, landscaping, etc., on State highways, within said municipality, which by law and/or agreement come under the jurisdiction and control of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois hereinafter referred to as Department; and

WHEREAS, an individual working permit must be obtained from the Department prior to any of the aforesaid installations being constructed either by the Municipality or by a private person or firm under contact and supervision of the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the Municipality:

FIRST: That Municipality hereby pledges its good faith and guarantees that all work shall be performed in accordance with conditions of the permit to be granted by the Department, and to hold State of Illinois harmless during the prosecution of such work, and assume all liability for damages to person or property due to accidents or otherwise by reason of the work which it to be performed under the provision of said permit.

SECOND: That all authorized officials of the Municipality are hereby instructed and authorized to sign said working permit on behalf of the Municipality.
