**SUBJECT:** Consideration of an Ordinance Repealing Title 2, Chapters 2,4, 6, 7 & 9 of the Village Code related to Boards and Commissions

**SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:**

At their August 26, 2019 meeting, the Environmental Commission voted to dissolve their commission and recommend that the Park Commission take over their 2 key projects: the Community Garden and Eco-Fair. They have indicated that former members of the Environmental Commission would be interested in volunteering on those projects.

While preparing the ordinance dissolving the commission, staff discovered a number of other commissions listed in the Village Code that no longer meet or have memberships. The chapters establishing those commissions are included in the repealing ordinance as well.

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**ORDINANCE 19-10-xx**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING REPEALING TITLE 2, CHAPTERS 2, 4, 6, 7 & 9 OF THE VILLAGE CODE RELATED TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS**

**WHEREAS**, at the August 26, 2019 Environmental Commission Meeting, members in attendance voted to dissolve their commission and recommended that the Park Commission take over their two principal projects, namely the Community Garden and Eco-Fair, effective September 1, 2019 , and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that the Parks Department has staff who could help take over these events, considering that former members of the environmental commission have expressed an intention to volunteer to help on these projects, and

**WHEREAS**, while reviewing the village code related to Boards and Commissions in preparation of the initial draft of this ordinance, Staff discovered that there are a number of other commissions listed in the Village Code which no longer have memberships or meet on a regular basis, and

**WHEREAS**, these commissions include the Board of Local Improvements, Redevelopment Commission, Economic Development Commission, and Electrical Commission, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Local Improvements, Chapter 2 of Title 2, was formed in 1935 for the purpose of determining where to install infrastructure and to find funding therefore, and this Board has not met for at least several decades, and

**WHEREAS**, the Redevelopment Commission, Chapter 4 of Title 2, was formed in 1985 in order to implement a redevelopment project area which has since been fully redeveloped, and the Commission has not met for over 10 years, and

**WHEREAS**, the Economic Development Commission, Chapter 6 of Title 2, was established in 1993 for the purpose of the promoting and encouraging economic growth, but fell out of use approximately 15 years ago and their basic functions are now in the purview of the Economic Development Task Force created in 2017, which currently meets regularly, and

**WHEREAS**, the Electrical Commission, Chapter 7 of Title 2, was charged with making recommendations of sage and practical standards for the installation, alteration and use of electrical equipment design. Such rules and regulations are now adopted by the Village Board, at the recommendation of staff, and utilize the National Electrical Code and other applicable standard building codes, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Antioch, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Title 2 of the Antioch Municipal Code is hereby amended by the repeal of Chapters 2, 4, 6, 7 & 9.

**SECTION TWO:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
