SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

The attached applications were submitted by Drivetime Indoor Golf, LLC and Crystal Nails Spa for a BYOB License pursuant to Village Code Section 4-2B-10(J), which permits non-restaurant establishments to apply for a BYOB Liquor License. As approved via Ordinance No. 20-06-19, the Village Board shall review each application for a non-restaurant BYOB License and either approve or deny by a majority vote.

The applicants presented their requests for a BYOB license at the February 24, 2021 Committee of the Whole meeting, and those present agreed to place the requests on a Village Board agenda for consideration.

**WHEREAS**, Petitioner has filed an application seeking a Class J BYOB license with the Village Clerk, which application complies with all requirements of Section 4-2B-10(J) of the Antioch Municipal Code, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has allowed the Petitioner to present its petition in the Committee of the Whole held on February 24, 2021, and is fully informed of the representations made by the Petitioner as to the intentions of the business to comply in all material respects with the business management aspects and limitations described in Section 4-2B-10(J), and being otherwise fully informed in the premises, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board finds that the Petitioner has presented a petition and business model which can reasonably be expected to expand the entertainment opportunities available to the public without introducing additional burdens on law enforcement or other municipal services, and as such should be approved;
