SUBJECT: Consideration and approval of an Ordinance changing the name of W Depot Street to Haley Street from Cunningham Drive to Hillside Avenue within the Village of Antioch, Illinois

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

Due to his former contributions to the community, it was discussed at the July 27, 2022 Committee of the Whole meeting to honor former Mayor Michael J. Haley in some fashion. After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed upon to rename the portion of W Depot Street between Cunningham and Hillside as Haley Street. This roadway fronts the Hiram Buttrick Sawmill, which was erected during Mike's term as Mayor. A number of mayors who served prior to former Mayor Haley have had streets named after them, including Wilton, Cunningham, Toft, McMillen (to name a few).

ORDINANCE 22-08-43

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF W DEPOT STREET TO HALEY STREET FROM CUNNINGHAM DRIVE TO HILLSIDE AVENUE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ANTIOCH, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Antioch, Illinois (the “Village”) is a non-home rule municipality organized and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et seq.*); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, who is also the President of the Village (the “President”), and the Board of Trustees of the Village (collectively, the “Corporate Authorities”) are committed to recognizing and honoring residents who have made significant contributions to the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-80-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-19) the Corporate Authorities may name originally and then may change the name of any street, avenue, alley or other public place; and

WHEREAS, Michael “Mike” J. Haley was, among other things, a lifelong resident of the Village, the former Mayor of the Village, an accomplished elected official and a war veteran; and

WHEREAS, to honor and remember Michael J. Haley for his selfless service to his community, the Corporate Authorities have determined that W Depot Street from Cunningham Drive to Hillside Avenue should be renamed Haley Street in honor of the former Mayor Michael J. Haley;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Antioch, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

Section 1. Incorporation Clause.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section 2. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to designate and rename W Depot Street as Haley Street from Cunningham Drive to Hillside Avenue and to authorize the President or his designee to draft all necessary documents and perform all necessary acts to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

ARTICLE II. AUTHORIZATION

Section 3. Authorization.

The Corporate Authorities hereby approve changing the name of W Depot Street to Haley Street from Cunningham Drive to Hillside Avenue. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign any documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary. The Village Clerk is further authorized to notify the election authorities having jurisdiction in the Village and the post office branch serving that area of the Village of the change in street name, which notice shall be in writing and by certified or registered mail. The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize the Public Works Department of the Village to order the necessary signage and implement the street name change. The officers, agents and/or employees of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required by the Village to carry out, give effect to and effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith.

Section 4. Acts of Village Officials.

That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Ordinance are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

ARTICLE III. HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE

Section 5. Headings.

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance; nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Corporate Authorities that this Ordinance would have been adopted had not such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, section or part thereof been included.

Section 7. Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 8. Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force thirty (30) days after the election authorities having jurisdiction in the Village and the post office branch serving that area of the Village have been notified by the Corporate Authorities the change in writing by certified or registered mail.
